**MARYLAND YOUTH SCRATCH CHAMPIONSHIPS**  
**REGIONAL LEVEL RULES**



**1. Eligibility**

- a. The Maryland Youth Scratch Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
- b. **All youth members bowling in a certified youth league are eligible.** They must bowl in a center that is affiliated with an Association serviced by the MD State USBC or a youth league can request an exception, but the entire league must declare.
- c. Advancement ratio from the league to the Regional competition is one (1) in four (4).
- d. **Bowlers may enter only in one Regional and enter only once. Multiple participation is not permitted.**
- e. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one State/Regional will result in automatic disqualification.

**2. Events/Divisions**

- a. Regional competition will take place at a designated center, time, and place to be determined by the Regional Tournament Director.
- b. Competition will be conducted in 12 scratch divisions based on the participant's age and gender (boys and girls).

**DIVISIONS and BIRTH DATE INFO**

U8 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2017 or later.

U10 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2015 through 7/31/2017

U12 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2013 through 7/31/2015

U14 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2011 through 7/31/2013

U16 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2009 through 7/31/2011

U18 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2007 through 7/31/2009

- 3. Entry Deadline** - The entry deadline for all entries is determined by the Regional Director. Walk-ins must complete entry form and submit payment at least ½ hour before the start of each squad. Walk-in entries accepted based on lane availability and must have been qualified during league.

- 4. ENTRY FEES PER BOWLER:** See Regional schedule

**REFUNDS:** Refunds will only be granted up to the closing date for advanced entries. All refunds are at the discretion of the Regional tournament director. NO REFUNDS for no shows at the event. Refunds must be requested through the Regional Tournament director and must be in writing.

**5. Awards and Scholarships/Advancement**

- a. Scholarship fees shall be returned 100% to the bowlers at the State Finals.
- b. Advancement ratio to State level and scholarships awards shall be at least one (1) for every four (4) entries or major fraction thereof in each division. All ties for advancement shall advance.
- c. Bowlers will advance to the Youth Scratch Championships State Finals.
- d. Scholarship amounts to be awarded will be determined by the number of entries. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund, Account #12034.

**6. Other**

- a. All divisions shall bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes. Results will be determined by the total pin fall in each division. No substitutes will be permitted once

athletes have started tournament play.

- b. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes. The Regional director will set limits and be consistent throughout the event.
  - c. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0).
  - d. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
  - e. Claims regarding errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
  - f. The State competition will take place at Millsboro Lanes, 213 Mitchell Street, Millsboro, DE 19966.
  - g. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Maryland State Scratch USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director. The Scratch USBC Youth Championship Director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
7. **DRESS CODE** - All clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing is allowed. All T-shirts and collared shirts must have sleeves. Full length pants, capris, skirts, skorts and shorts are permissible. All skirts, skorts, and shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee. Tournament management will have the final say in determining if a competitor's clothing is acceptable for the tournament or not. No electronic devices may be worn during competition, except for medical purposes. This includes headphones and ear buds. A request for exception shall be in writing and approved by the tournament director prior to competition.
8. **Penalty:** First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from the competition.

**MARYLAND YOUTH SCRATCH CHAMPIONSHIPS**  
**STATE LEVEL RULES**



**1. Eligibility**

- a. The Maryland Youth Scratch Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
- b. Advancement ratio from the previous competition (Regional) to State competition shall be at least one (1) for every four (4) entries or major fraction thereof, but at least two (2). All ties for advancement shall advance.
- c. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state or Regional will result in automatic disqualification.

**2. Events and Divisions**

- a. The state competition will take place on April 11-12, 2026, bowled at Millsboro Lanes, 213 Mitchell Street, Millsboro, DE 19966.
- b. The entry closing date is March 31, 2026. State finalists will receive entry form and information from the Regional tournament director at the end of Regional competition.
- c. The competition will be conducted in 12 scratch divisions based on the participant's age and gender listed below (boys and girls).

**DIVISIONS and BIRTH DATE INFO**

U8 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2017 or later.

U10 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2015 through 7/31/2017

U12 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2013 through 7/31/2015

U14 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2011 through 7/31/2013

U16 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2009 through 7/31/2011

U18 - Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2007 through 7/31/2009

- 3. Handicap** - This is a scratch tournament, no handicap.

- 4. Format** – U8 and U10 divisions (boys and girls) will bowl three 3 games on one (1) pair of lanes with total pinfall determining the scratch winners. U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions (boys and girls) will bowl 6 games across two (2) pair of lanes with total pinfall determining top five (5) advancers in their respective divisions. Top five (5) advancers will compete in a one (1) game stepladder finals to determine winners.

- 5. Entry Fee - \$20.00 (lineage \$15.00) U8 and U10 divisions, \$40.00 (Lineage \$30.00) U12, U14, U16 & U18 divisions**

**6. Awards and Scholarships/Advancement**

- a. Awards & Scholarships: Symbolic awards and Scholarships will be awarded for at least one (1) in every five entries of major fraction thereof per division. Total scholarship dollars will be offered based on participation. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART Account #12034.
- b. In case of ties for scholarship positions, other than Stepladder finals. The scholarship monies for affected positions will be combined and divided equally.
- c. The first-place winners (or highest finishing athlete who has not already advanced) of the U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions for both Girls and Boys will advance to the 2026 Junior Gold Championships. They must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance to the Junior Gold Championships. Bowlers without a current Junior Gold membership must purchase a Junior Gold membership prior to June 8. IBC Youth will waive the \$250 (U18) and (U16), \$200 (U14), and \$150 (U12) entry fee for these athletes.

- d. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the Junior Gold Championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All U.S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team USA 2026 to represent the United States in national and international competition. If the U12, U14, U16 or U18 Division Champion is unwilling to become a Junior Gold member, they will not advance to the Junior Gold Championships. However, the athlete will still retain the state scholarship, but the berth to the Junior Gold Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete.

In the event that a qualifier needs to be replaced and there is a tie to determine who will advance to the Junior Gold Championships, the high game from the qualifying scores will determine who will advance. If the high score for each is the same, the next subsequent high score will be used until the tie is broken.

Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level. If the eligible advancer decides not to attend the Junior Gold Championships, any scholarship earned at the state level will be retained.

## 7. Other

- a. No substitutions are permitted; however, replacements may be used for bowlers not present 15 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time. **Replacements must be in order of finish from the prior level of competition, Regionals.**
- b. Ties in the Divisions affecting Junior Gold finalists only will be broken using the high game from the qualifying scores will determine who will advance. If the high score for each is the same, the next subsequent high score will be used until the tie is broken.
- c. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
- d. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
- e. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
- f. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of the competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
- g. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Pennsylvania State Scratch USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director. The State Scratch USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

- b. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
- c. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
- d. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of the competition. An exciting new era for Youth Bowling. This competition (formerly Pepsi Youth Championships) has been rebranded as the USBC Youth Championships presented by SMART.

## What's New?

New NAME, same Mission

Age based Divisions aligned with Junior Gold: Competition will now be held in U12, U14, U16, U18 divisions. U8 and U10 will still be offered but only at the Youth Scratch Championships.

## How it Works:

League level qualifying is still 2 consecutive weeks in November and 2 consecutive weeks in January.

Advancement to Regional competition on a One (1) in Four (4) basis.

Division winners at the State level earn a berth to the Junior Gold Championships.

## Junior Gold Membership Notes:

Junior Gold membership is not required to compete at the League, Regional and State levels.

If an athlete wins a qualifying division and is not a member, they must obtain Junior Gold membership prior to May 15 to compete in the Junior gold Championships.

If membership is not obtained, athlete retains and earned awards but will not advance to Junior Gold.

## Opportunities for Youth Bowlers:

To compete nationally starting at the league level.

Earned recognition, awards and scholarships.

Gain eligibility for Junior Gold and further scholarship opportunities.

## Important Instructions:

Use the league level rules provided to conduct qualifying competition.

Rules must be followed and shared with every participating athlete.

**\*\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT RULE: ALL Youth Scratch Championship Events will be conducted on a SCRATCH basis only. These events will be run with 12 divisions (U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 and U18 for each Boys and Girls).**

To protect bowlers' eligibility to participate in high school and/or collegiate level varsity sports, USBC rules mandate use of USBC's SMART (Scholarship Management and Accounting Reports for Tenpins) program for all scholarship awards assigned to USBC Youth members from certified league and tournament competition. All scholarship prize awards must be forwarded to USBC Headquarters for deposit with the SMART program within 30 days after the end of the tournament (USBC Rules 301d and 309). Therefore, all scholarship dollars assigned and awarded in connection to the Youth Scratch Championships at the league, center, sectional, and/or state/zone level must be forwarded to SMART.

- A current BPAA list will be provided to each Regional Director.

The Youth Scratch Championships begins with league level qualifying. Bowling centers with certified USBC Youth leagues are automatic qualifying sites. Since qualifying begins during league level, there is no entry fee at this level. **League level qualifying will be between Nov. 1, 2025 and Jan. 31, 2026. Please note: Please contact your state/zone Youth Scratch Championship Director if your league needs to take advantage of a window earlier than the one specified by your state/zone.**

The U12, U14, U16 and U18 Division Champions from the state finals will receive a berth from IBC Youth into the 2026 Junior Gold Championships. IBC Youth will waive the \$250 (U18 & U16), \$200 (U14) and \$150 (U12) entry fee for the U12, U14, U16 and U18 Division Champions. There, the bowlers will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the Junior Gold Championships. ## 2025-2026 LEAGUE LEVEL RULES

(ATHLETES MUST SEE THESE RULES  
AND CHOOSE THEIR OWN DIVISION)

1. The USBC Youth Scratch Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. Competition is open to all 2025-2026 USBC Youth members. To compete, a bowler must be a regular member of a certified USBC league and not be under suspension at the time of qualifying. League substitutes are allowed to participate if it is their only USBC Youth league. USBC Collegiate members are eligible if they are 2025-2026 USBC Youth members, bowl in a USBC Youth league and have not violated USBC Rule 400.
3. All USBC Youth members in good standing are eligible for the league level competition. There is no entry fee at the league level. Bowling centers having 2025-2026 USBC certified leagues are automatic league level qualifying sites.
4. **Participants must be aware of each competition level in the state and all associated rules, fees and deadlines. These items are contained in the specific state rules from the State Youth Scratch Championships tournament director. (State director information can be found on [BOWL.COM](http://BOWL.COM).)**
5. Competition will be conducted in 12 divisions based on the participant’s date of birth as listed below. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification. Bowlers must stay in the given division in that particular league throughout the entire window.

6. League level qualifying will be conducted in certified leagues during the qualifying window(s) between Nov 1, 2025 and January 31, 2026. Each state Youth Scratch Championship tournament committee decides the qualifying window dates. Consult state rules for the specific dates. **If needed, the state Youth Scratch Championship tournament director can grant changes in the qualifying dates to individual bowling centers.**

7. Qualifying scores must be bowled during regularly scheduled league play. **Pre-bowled or post-bowled scores may not be used as scores for advancement purposes.** Advancement to the next competition level will be from the League Level.
8. Participants must remain in the same division for the duration of that window. Bowlers are eligible to compete in a different division in a different league during the league level of competition.
9. USBC earned awards are based on the member's league average as of that day.
10. League level qualifying will be conducted in certified leagues during the qualifying window(s):
  - **1st Window:** Any two consecutive weeks from November 1 through November 29, 2025.
  - **2nd Window:** Any two consecutive weeks from January 3 through January 31, 2026.

**If needed, the state Youth Scratch Championship Director can grant changes in the qualifying dates to individual bowling centers.**

Qualifying scores must be bowled during regularly scheduled league play. **Pre-bowled or post-bowled scores may not be used as scores for advancement purposes.** Advancement to the next competition level will be from the league level.

11. Participants can attempt to qualify in any state where they hold a 2025-2026 USBC Youth membership card. However, the bowler can only advance once using the following criteria:
  - A. In the event a bowler qualifies in more than one league in the same division, the bowler must advance from the league in which the highest series was bowled. For identical qualifying scores, the member will advance from the league where the first score was bowled.
  - B. If a bowler qualifies in different leagues from multiple divisions, the bowler must select one division they will compete in before subsequent competition.
  - C. If the bowler advances out of league level in more than one state, the bowler **must** declare one state to continue competing in before the next competition level.
  - D. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state and/or more than one division will result in automatic **disqualification**.

***Note: Advancers remain in the division they qualified in during the league level in all subsequent competition. If there is a tie for the last-place qualifier in a division, both will advance to the next level of competition.***

#### **STATE LEVEL**

12. The top one (1) bowler in both the U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions for boys and girls at the state competition who wins the stepladder final will earn a berth to the Junior Gold Championships to be held July of 2026. Bowlers are not required to have a minimum average or be a Junior Gold Program member to enter the U12, U14, U16 or U18 Divisions at the local level of qualifying for the Youth Scratch Championships. However, to receive the berth, the bowler must be a USBC Youth Standard member and USBC Junior Gold program member prior to the Junior Gold Championships. **If the winner is not eligible for the championships, he/she will still retain all awards from the state, but the next eligible bowler will receive the berth to the Junior Gold Championships.**
13. Advancers to the Junior Gold Championships must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level.
14. Failure to abide by any rules and regulations will lead to disqualification from this event. The Youth Scratch Championships National Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

## GUIDELINES FOR LEAGUE OFFICIALS/PROGRAM DIRECTORS

The following are general guidelines to help you conduct the league level competition. The packet and information from your state Youth Scratch Championship tournament director will have specific information. **This event is provided for all USBC Youth members -- do not disappoint your bowlers. USBC Youth members deserve your assistance!**



It is **not** mandatory to use the provided league worksheets. It is acceptable to produce the required information on your computer through a league secretary program. CDE Software and Treasure Software produce league secretary software that contains the USBC Youth Championships forms. Please enter all information accurately. If you want to purchase software, please contact the company directly: CDE Software at (206) 937- 8927 ([cdesoftware.com](http://cdesoftware.com)), or Treasure Software at (800) 552-2695 ([treasuresoftware.com](http://treasuresoftware.com)). **Each athlete is required to read the league level rules and agree to the division in which they have been placed for this tournament.**

### COMPETITION SET-UP

Locate your qualifying window dates provided in this packet. **If the dates conflict with other league or center obligations, please notify your State Youth Scratch Championship Director, Evelyn Testerman at 410-459-2023 or by email at [mdusbc@yahoo.com](mailto:mdusbc@yahoo.com). She has the authority to change these dates for you.**

### STEP-BY-STEP PLAN FOR ALL QUALIFYING WINDOWS

1. The week before the league level competition begins, inform the bowlers and parents that the league will be participating in the Youth Scratch Championships.

**Make copies of the League Level Rules included in this handbook and pass them out to the bowlers and parents. All athletes must read and be aware of these rules.**

2. Locate the league worksheet in this handbook. Make a worksheet for each division. "Division" corresponds to the tournament's 12 divisions: Boys Divisions of U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 and U18. Girls Divisions of U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 and U18. All divisions will be SCRATCH.
3. Before the window begins, ask each league member to choose the division he or she wishes to bowl in and enter their name on the corresponding worksheet. **Divisions are based on bowler's age.** Make sure you check the ages to be sure the bowlers are participating in the correct divisions. Bowlers can participate in a different division for each league in which they are members, regardless of center. However, the bowler must remain in that division for that league during the entire window.
4. During this window USBC earned awards are based on the league average not the tournament average.
5. After the first league session, enter the scratch series for each participant in the "first week" row of the league worksheet. **If a member is not physically present this week, list his or her score as absent/"0." Pre-bowled and post-bowled scores are not allowed.**
6. During the second week, remind league members they are competing in the Youth Scratch Championships qualifying competition. This week is a second chance to bowl in a qualifying series. Include the same number of participants as in the first week. After the league session, enter the scratch series again on the League Worksheet. **Reminder: If a member is not physically present this week, list his or her score as absent/"0." Pre-bowled and post-bowled scores are not allowed.**
7. Determine each participant's highest series and circle that score.

**Do not add the first-week and second-week scores together. Each week is a separate opportunity for the bowler to post a score.** The bowler's highest series is the score used for qualifying. A participant does not need to be present both weeks to qualify.

8. Using the scores you have just circled, rank the bowlers by best qualifying score. Using the advancement ratio set by your state Youth Scratch Tournament Director; determine the bowler(s) who advance in that division in that league. After determining who has qualified, notify the winners. (Please inform the participants who qualified bowling only two games that they will bowl at least three games at the next competition level.) It is the winner's choice to advance to the next level and pay all applicable fees.
9. On the league worksheet, show the bowlers who have qualified and accepted or declined to advance to the next competition level. **Remember, each division per league must advance at least one person regardless of the ratio and the number of bowlers participating in that division.**
10. Since bowlers were given several qualifying opportunities, some may have advanced in more than one division and/or more than once in the same division. **A participant can only advance once into the next competition level regardless of the ways he or she qualified. A bowler automatically is disqualified if he or she attempts to advance more than once.** If a participant should win in multiple qualifiers, the following guidelines will decide where the bowler advances from:
  - a. If qualified in more than one state, choose one state.
  - b. If qualified in more than one division, choose one division.
  - c. If qualified in the same division during both windows, he or she advances from the first window.
  - d. If a bowler qualified in more than one league in the same division during a window, he or she must advance from the league in which the highest series was bowled.

Remember some of your bowlers might bowl in different bowling centers. Check to make sure they are only advancing from one center. **In all cases, once a bowler has made the choice to advance from a certain state and division, he or she forfeits advancing in other states, centers and divisions.**
11. Once you have figured out how many bowlers will advance per league and who they are, enter the information on the bottom of the league level worksheet. Complete one form per division per league.
12. After completing your league worksheet, make copies for your files and send the originals to your Regional Youth Scratch Championship tournament director.

## REGIONAL LEVEL RULES

1. The Youth Scratch Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. The Maryland State USBC Youth will conduct two qualifying windows. The qualifying windows dates for entries are as follows: **1st Window:** Any consecutive two weeks between November 1 through November 29, 2025; **2nd Window:** Any two consecutive weeks between January 3 through January 31, 2026; **Replacements must advance from the same league and window based on order of finish.**
3. Advancement ratio from the previous competition (league) to Regional competition is at least one (1) for every four (4) entries per division, including last place ties. In all cases at least two person per division shall advance. There is a ratio chart in the back of the manual
4. Advancers out of league level must remain in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state/zone, the bowler must declare one state/zone to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/zone will result in automatic disqualification. **Bowlers must declare at the time of their first qualifying window within EACH league if they choose to “PLAY UP” to a higher age division. All bowlers that choose to “PLAY UP” MUST COMPLETE a “PLAY UP” Waiver PRIOR to competition.**
5. Regional competition will take place at a designated center, time and place to be determined by the Regional Tournament Director. (Please visit our web site for an updated Regional Level Schedule, )
6. Entry closing date for the regional level will be determined by the regional directors.
7. Competition will be conducted in 12 divisions based on the participant’s age as listed below. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification. Bowlers must stay in the given division in that particular league throughout the entire window.

8. All divisions shall bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes. Results will be determined by total pin fall in each division.

10. UNDER 8 & UNDER 10 - Expenses: \$5.00 Lineage: \$15.00 Total - \$20.00  
UNDER 12, 14, 16 & 20 - Expenses: \$10.00 Lineage: \$30.00 Total - \$40.00
11. All bowlers must wear suitable attire as per the State USBC Youth Tournament Dress Code. Penalty: First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from the competition.
12. No substitutions will be permitted once athletes have started tournament play however replacements may be used for bowlers not present 15 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time. **Replacements must be from order of finish from prior level of competition, Districts.**
13. Competitors shall be allowed up to 5 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
14. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
15. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
16. Scholarships plus awards will be given to the top 5 bowlers in each division. Ties in the Divisions affecting Junior Gold finalists only, will be broken by a one game roll-off. Should a tie still exist, it will be broken with an additional 9th and 10th frame roll-off, until a winner is determined.
17. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
18. Scholarships will be awarded for every one (1) in ten (10) entries per division at the State Level. The State Youth Scratch Championship Tournament Committee will determine the scholarships awarded. Total scholarship dollars offered based on participation. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund.
19. The top one (1) bowler in both the U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions for boys and girls at the state competition who wins the stepladder final will earn a berth to the Junior Gold Championships to be held July 2026. Bowlers are not required to have a minimum average or be a Junior Gold Program member to enter the U12, U14, U16 or U18 Divisions at the local level of qualifying for the Youth Scratch Championships. However, to receive the berth, the bowler must be a USBC Youth Standard member and USBC Junior Gold program member prior to the Junior Gold Championships. **If the winner is not eligible for the championships, he/she will still retain all awards from the state, but the next eligible bowler will receive the berth to the Junior Gold Championships.**
20. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level.
21. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Maryland State USBC Association State Youth Scratch Tournament Director –Evelyn Testerman at 410-459-2023 or by email at mdusbc@yahoo.com. The tournament director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
