# Nebraska Youth Scratch Championship Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC rules. Participants must be a member of the USBC youth division.
2. This is an open entry tournament. Entry is open to all USBC Youth Members competing in a 2025-2026 Certified USBC League within the State of Nebraska.
3. State Competition will take place at **Westbrook Lanes 3156 51<sup>st</sup> Ave., Columbus, NE 688601** Squads will be held on **October 18th, 19<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> & 26th 2025**. Additional dates may be added to the event related to the weather.

5. Entries close **October 6, 2025**. Register online at <https://webapps.bowl.com/USBC.Registration/registration?tags=NEState81051> Entries postmarked after **October 7, 2025** will be accepted as space allows. Please call for space availability before sending in a late entry.
6. Divisions are based on the participant's age. Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions:

U8 Boys and U8 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2017 or Later
U10 Boys and U10 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2015 thru 7/31/2017
U12 Boys and U12 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2013 thru 7/31/2015
U14 Boys and U14 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2011 thru 7/31/2013
U16 Boys and U16 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate Is 8/1/2009 thru 7/31/2011
U18 Boys and U18 Girls	Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2007 thru 7/31/2009

7. The tournament format shall be Divisions U8 and U10 will bowl three games at the state level, total pin fall will determine final standings. Divisions U12, U14, U16 and U18 will bowl six games, moving to another pair of lanes after 3 games, total pin fall will determine final standings. The Lane movement is subject to change based on current COVID-19 restrictions and local health mandates. The tournament director will announce the final lane movement sequence prior to the start of the tournament.

9. Awards and scholarships fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers. Scholarship money will be held in SMART account **#8532**. Scholarships will be awarded to the top three places in every division.

a. U8/U10	First Place: \$75	Second Place: \$50	Third Place: \$25
b. U12/U14	First Place: \$200	Second Place: \$125	Third Place: \$100
c. U16/U18	First Place: \$250	Second Place: \$175	Third Place: \$125

**\*\*Please note these are the guaranteed prize amounts. Additional funds may be added based on the number of entries in the division and fundraising totals.**

10. In the event of a tie, either for scholarship or Junior Gold advancement, the highest game in the tournament will be used to break the tie. If the highest game is a tie, the next subsequent highest game will be used until the tie is broken.

11. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Bowlers must wear collared shirts or bowling jerseys and slacks, or wear shorts or skorts. Shorts and skorts must be mid-thigh length. No gym shorts or tops, no yoga or compression pants, no jeans or leggings, no t-shirts, or attire with alcohol, tobacco or inappropriate wording or figures will be allowed. The tournament director has the discretion to ask the bowler to change. No hats or caps allowed.
12. No cigarettes, E-Cigs or vaping will be allowed in the bowling center during tournament play.
13. Alcohol must remain in the bar and cannot be consumed in the bowling area or tournament viewing areas.
14. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. A bowler not present to bowl when it is their turn to bowl will be credited with a zero for that frame.
15. Competitors shall be allowed ten minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
16. All divisions will be bowling scratch on an unnamed pattern. The pattern name and details will be released upon completion of all squads of the tournament.
17. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
18. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
19. The first-place winner of the U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions for both boys and girls will advance to the 2026 Junior Gold Championships. Winners must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance. Bowlers without a current Junior Gold Membership must purchase a Junior Gold Membership prior to May 1, 2026. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All US Citizens are vying for a spot on the USBC Junior Team USA 2026 to represent the United States in national and international competition. If the U12, U14, U16 or U18 Division Winner is unwilling or unable to become a Junior Gold Member they will not advance to the Junior Gold Championships. However, the athlete will still retain the state scholarship, but the berth to the Junior Gold Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete. Winners in the U12, U14, U16 and U18 divisions receive no financial support. Winners are not confirmed as international finalists until they receive a confirmation letter or email from USBC. Advancers will be required to be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or coach. If a qualifier needs to be replaced and there is a tie to determine who will advance to the Junior Gold Championships, the high game from the qualifying scores will determine who will advance. If the high score for each is the same, the next subsequent high score(s) will be used until the tie is broken.
20. U8 and U10 boy's and girl's division winners do not advance beyond state competition.
21. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Nebraska Youth Scratch Championship Committee. The Nebraska Youth Scratch Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
22. Failure to abide by any rules and regulations will lead to disqualification from this event.
23. All bowlers must see and understand these rules.
