- 1. This tournament is open to every 2024-2025 USBC Youth bowler that is a regular member of a certified league at a participating NJ bowling center. To compete, a bowler must not be under suspension.
  - a. This tournament is certified Scratch #05412 and Handicap #05413 by USBC and shall be governed by USBC rules.
  - b. U8 Boys Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2016 or later

    U10 Boys Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2014 thru 7/31/2016

    U12 Boys Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2012 thru 7/31/2014

    U18 Boys Bowlers whose birth date is 8/1/2006 thru 7/31/2009
    U18 Girls
- 2. LEAGUE LEVEL QUALIFYING COMPETITION: League level dates are Nov 2 15, 2024 & Jan 4– Jan 17, 2025. Advancement from league play is a one-time event. If an individual qualifies but cannot participate in this competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish at the place of qualification, from the respective division.
  - a. The highest 2 games series in 2 game leagues or 3 game series in 3 game leagues will be used to qualify. Qualifying scores must be bowled during regularly scheduled league play. Prebowled or post-bowled scores may not be used as scores for advancement purposes.
  - b. If a member qualifies in more than one league, the bowler must advance from the league in which the highest series was bowled. If qualifying scores are identical the bowler will advance from the league where the first score was bowled.
  - c. Advancement ratio from League Competition is one bowler for every three entries (1:3) per division, per league, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties. The base number for each league is the number of league members that would have participated in that division.
  - d. Advancers out of the league level must remain in the division they qualified.
  - e. <u>COMPLETED</u> entries with worksheets from the League Level Qualifying sessions, and proper fees made payable to NJS Bowling Council must be received by: November entries by <u>December 23, 2024</u> and the January/February entries by <u>February 15, 2025</u>. ALL information, including signatures, must be completed and legible. If they are not, the entries will not be accepted. Please follow the entry closing dates listed above and mail in advance to insure receipt of the closing date(s).
- 3. Competition will take place at <u>Majestic Lanes, 525 Route 9, Hopelawn, NJ. 08861</u>. Replacement bowlers will be eligible based on the order of finish in the League Level Qualifying. All entrants in the U8, U10, U12, U15, U18 will bowl four games on the same pair of lanes.
  - a. No changes to squad date or time will be made 72 hours prior to competition. Substitutes will be accepted up to 72 hours prior to first squad.
  - b. Ties to determine first place standing at the State Finals will be broken with a one game roll-off plus handicap if applicable. If a tie still exists, it will be broken with 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-offs plus 1/10<sup>th</sup> of the handicap per frame where applicable.
- 4. There will be a one-time **non-refundable fee** of \$35.00. 100% of scholarship and award fees will be returned to bowlers. The scholarship money is held by the USBC SMART Program. To receive your scholarship, you may contact USBC, Smart Division.
- GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION This section applies to all levels of competition.
   a. Bowlers will receive five minutes of practice on their starting lanes.

- b. All bowlers must wear suitable attire, i.e., no hats, tank tops, pants falling down, or ripped clothing will be permitted. Clothing with obscene language or graphics, tobacco and/or alcohol advertising will not be permitted. "Official" USBC Youth Jersey may be worn.
- c. A bowler arriving late shall begin play, and score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with zeros. Bowlers not present to bowl when it is their turn may be credited with a zero for that frame.
- d. Bowler shall compete with the same bowling hand, consistent with USBC Youth membership, throughout all tournament levels as indicated on the entry form and bowled at the league qualifying level.
- e. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next squad or 30 minutes after completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the State Tournament Director within 72 hours after competition, in accordance with rule 329. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
- f. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the New Jersey State USBC Youth Tournament Committee.

- h. Tournament Director reserves all rights.
- i. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations will lead to disqualification from this event.
- 6. Averages will be verified and adjusted as needed. Failure to provide proof of average is grounds to disqualify a bowler from competition.
  - a. Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average of 15 games or more as of February 28, 2025, Bowlers who do not have an average for 15 games or more shall use an average of 220.
  - b. If a bowler does not have a standard league average as specified above, the bowler must then use their adjusted Sport Bowling average as specified in rule #202 or an adjusted tournament average established during past competitions.
  - c. Averages must be submitted by center in alphabetic order for those that qualify. Standing sheets will not be accepted.
  - d. Average from the bowlers qualifying center will be used for handicap purposes.
- 7. The handicap will be 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
- 8. Only bowlers and tournament officials are permitted in the settee (bowling) area. New Jersey is a nonsmoking state and there will be no smoking the Bowling Centers at any time.
- 9. The Pepsi Youth Championships allows parents/players to request a WAIVER to allow their player to "play up" into an older group in the U8 and U10 divisions only. Requests and any approval granted are for the current season's tournament only. Requests are by written application only by the parent or legal guardian. While the Pepsi Youth Championships does not recommend that players play up, the tournament leadership does recognize that there may be a number of factors, including but not limited to, size, maturity, experience, and skill levels that may influence a player's decision to play up. Waiver Form is included with this information.
- The Scratch Division is considered a Premiere Event. The winners of the U12, U15, U18 Scratch divisions (boys and girls) will be awarded spots to the Junior Gold Championships to be held in Green Bay Wisconsin (July 11 - 19, 2025). USBC will pay the Junior Gold entry fee. Winners must meet all qualifications for USBC Junior Gold membership.
  - a. Winners must agree to bowl in the Internationals Finals. Failure to do so waive all rights excluding State earned scholarships. Should an individual choose not to accept their spot from the 2024 2025 New Jersey Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Scholarship Tournament, replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their respective division at the State competition. Replacements will incur all expenses associated with changing the airline ticket if applicable. In the event that a qualifier needs to be replaced and there is a tie to determine who will advance to the Junior Gold Championships, the high game from the qualifying scores will determine who will advance. If the high score for each is the same, the next subsequent high score will be used until the tie is broken.
  - b. Winners are not confirmed as international finalists until they receive a confirmation letter from USBC.

- c. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
- d. Those advancing to the USBC Junior Gold Championships will not receive a stipend.
