1. The Texas State Pepsi USBC Youth Championships will be held March 16-17, 2024 at Forum Bowl, 2001 S .Great Southwest Pkwy., Grand Prairie, TX. 75050 (phone: 972-647-2275). Squad times will be 9:00 AM and 12:00 NOON on Saturday and 9:00 AM and 12:00 NOON on Sunday. Additional squads will be scheduled if needed.
2. Entrants should check in with their USBC card. Entrants may not qualify more than once from the league level, and must participate in the division through which they qualified. League qualifying dates are November 4 - 17, 2023 and January 6 - 19, 2024
3. The ratio from league to state is at least one for every 5 bowlers per division or major fraction (3 and 4 are major fractions) including last place ties. In all cases at least one bowler per division shall advance. The advancement ratio shall be applied uniformly to all eligible divisions. If an individual qualified and cannot participate in the state competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish in the previous qualifying event. Entrants must be TEXAS USBC Youth members. No substitutes will be permitted; however, replacements may be used for bowlers not present when practice starts for that squad.
4. Advancers out of the league level must compete in the division in which they qualified. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state / zone, the bowler must declare one state / zone to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state / zone will result in automatic disqualification.
5. **Texas will be offering the Mary Antell handicap scholarship division (free of charge) in each of the same age divisions. Entrants must attach a copy of their average verification to their entry form or the bowler will be entered with a 200 average .Handicap will be 100% of 200.** (a) Entrants must use the highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more as listed on bowl.com. (b). If no bowl.com average, the bowler will use their highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. A January 1<sup>st</sup> standing sheet must be stapled to the entry form. (c). If a certified "sport" league average is the youth's only average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport adjustment chart to determine the average to be used. (d). If no a, b, or c exist the bowler can use a current average of 9 games or more or past average whichever is higher (Tournament Directors decision is final). (e). If no a,b,c,or d, the bowler will use a 200 average.
6. ENTRY CLOSING DATE IS FEBRUARY 17, 2024. ENTRY FORM AND FEES must be postmarked by that date to the tournament director.
7. ENTRY FEE is \$35.00 per entry. Entry fee breakdown is \$15.00 Bowling fee, \$15.00 Scholarship / award fee, \$5.00 expense fee. Entry fee must accompany entry. **Entry fee will not be refunded.** ENTRY FEE MUST BE REMITTED BY CASHIERS CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. **ENTRY WITH PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE RETURNED TO SENDER.** Make CASHIERS CHECK OR MONEY ORDER PAYABLE to TSUSBC. Symbolic awards will be in each division with a minimum of four per division. A pen will be given to each participant. SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded on a ratio of 1 for 20 to bowlers in all divisions, with a minimum of \$50.00. Award and scholarship fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers. Ties will be added together and divided equally.
8. Entrants will bowl four (4) games on the same pair of lanes with 10 minutes of practice. All bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame that is being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn should be reported to the tournament official for a ruling as to whether or not the bowler will be credited with a zero for that frame.
9. Most total pins scratch in the U12 boys and girls divisions for a total of two (2) will determine the qualifiers who receive a paid entry into the USBC Junior Gold Championships. Athletes must be USBC Junior Gold Program Members or purchase a membership to advance. (No travel reimbursement or stipend will be provided for these bowlers, however, workers will raffle bowling balls to help with Expenses. Donations will be divided among all qualifiers advancing to USBC Jr. Gold).
10. ONLY BOWLERS and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
11. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than or 30 minutes after the completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
12. PROPER ATTIRE MUST BE WORN. Participants can wear long pants/jeans (no sweatpants). Girls will be allowed to wear skorts but **NO SHORTS are allowed. No holes in pants or shirts** .No hats or caps in bowler's area. Bowling shirts are preferred but all shirts must have sleeves and be long enough to touch the pants. No alcohol, gaming, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. Decision on attire will be made by tournament official.
13. NO FLASH CAMERAS ALLOWED AFTER THE SQUAD HAS STARTED. THERE WILL BE NO SMOKING IN THE AREA WHERE THE TOURNAMENT IS BOWLING.
14. After an entry has been received, and the dates assigned by the tournament management, the entry fee cannot be refunded.
15. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Committee. This tournament will be certified by USBC and all USBC rules will apply.

1. The Texas State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship will be held on March 15, 16, and 17, 2024 at **Cityview Lanes**, 6601 Oakmont Blvd., Fort Worth, TX, 76132. Squad times are 6:00 PM Friday, 9:00 AM, 11:30 AM, & 3:30 PM on Saturday, and 9:00 AM and 12:30 PM on Sunday.
2. Entrants should check in with their USBC card. Entrants may not qualify more than once from the league level, and must participate in the division through which they qualified. League qualifying dates are November 4- 17, 2023 and January 6 -19, 2024.
3. The ratio from league to state is at least one for every 5 bowlers per division or major fraction (3 and 4 are major fractions) including last place ties. In all cases at least one bowler per division shall advance. The advancement ratio shall be applied uniformly to all eligible divisions. Entrants may enter one time only. If an individual qualified and cannot participate in the state competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish in the previous qualifying event. Entrants must be TEXAS USBC Youth members. No substitutes will be permitted, however, replacements may be used for bowlers not present when practice starts for that squad.
4. Advancers out of the league level must bowl in the division they qualified in at the league level. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state / zone, the bowler must declare one state / zone to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state / zone will result in automatic disqualification.
5. **Texas will be offering the Mary Antell handicap scholarship division (free of charge) in each of the same age divisions. Entrants must staple a copy of their average verification to their entry form or the bowler will be entered with a 200 average.** Handicap will be 100% of 200. (a) Entrants must use the highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more including summer averages from the previous year. (b) If no previous year average, the bowler will use their highest USBC certified league average of 15 games or more as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. A January 1<sup>st</sup> standing sheet must be stapled to the entry form (c) If a certified "sport" league average is the youth's only average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport adjustment chart to determine the average to be used (d) If no a, b, or c exist the bowler can use a current final), (e). If no a,b,c,or d, the bowler will use a 200 average.
6. ENTRY CLOSING DATE IS FEBRUARY 17, 2024. Entry form and fees must be postmarked by that date to the tournament director.
7. ENTRY FEE is \$45.00 per entry. Entry fee breakdown is \$21.00 lineage, \$17.00 Scholarship / award fee, \$7.00 expense fee. Entry fee must accompany entry. ENTRY FEE MUST BE REMITTED BY CASHIERS CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. ENTRY WITH PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE RETURNED TO SENDER. Make CASHIERS CHECK OR MONEY ORDER PAYABLE TO TSUSBC. Symbolic awards will be given in each division with a minimum of four per division. A pen will be given to each participant. SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded on a ratio of 1 for 20 to bowlers in all divisions, with a minimum of \$50.00. Award and scholarship fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers. Ties will be added together and divided equally.
8. Entrants will bowl six (6) games on the same pair of lanes with 10 minutes of practice. All bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame that's being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn should be reported to the tournament official for a ruling as to whether or not the bowler will be credited with a zero for that frame.
9. Total pins scratch in all four divisions will determine the qualifiers who receive the paid entries into the USBC Junior Gold Championships. Athletes must be USBC Junior Gold Program Members or purchase a membership to advance. (No travel reimbursement or stipend will be provided for these bowlers, however workers will raffle bowling balls to help with expenses. Donations will be divided among all qualifiers advancing to USBC Junior Gold). Bowlers will be competing for additional scholarships at the USBC Junior Gold Championships.
10. ONLY BOWLERS and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
11. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
12. PROPER ATTIRE MUST BE WORN. Participants can wear long pants/jean (Sweatpants are not permitted) Girls can wear skorts, however **NO SHORTS OR SPANDEX. No holes in pants or shirts.** No hats or caps in bowler's area.. Bowling shirts are preferred but all shirts must have sleeves and be long enough to tuck in. No alcohol, gaming, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. Decisions on attire will be made by a tournament official.
13. NO FLASH CAMERAS ALLOWED AFTER THE SQUAD HAS STARTED. THERE WILL BE NO SMOKING IN THE AREA WHERE THE TOURNAMENT IS BOWLING.
14. After an entry has been received, and the dates assigned by the tournament management, the entry fee cannot be refunded.
15. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship committee. This tournament is certified by USBC and all USBC rules will apply.
